Our July meeting will be presented by David Genovese. He will present a program titled "Growing Orchids from Seed and De-flasking Demonstration". The program will be a brief talk about growing orchids from seed followed by a hands on demonstration of de-flasking and setting up com-pots using a couple of his own crosses. Volunteers will be asked to help during the de-flasking process. David will also bring his award winning educational display, which is all about growing orchids from seed.

David has been growing orchids for twenty three years with somewhat limited success until moving to

Naples, Florida in 2005. Shortly after that move from the suburbs of Washington DC his simple hobby became a flourishing passion, and he soon had a thriving collection. While David grows many genera of plants, his favorites are the Vandaceous group. In addition to caring for and exhibiting his plants, he also enjoys breeding both species and new hybrids, sharing with others about what he has learned and studying to become an AOS judge. At present he is finishing up his second year as a student judge for the West Palm Beach Judging Center.


