Angraecums tend to be known for their beautiful, showy flowers, many of which are fragrant at night. Some can even become fantastic

specimen plants in just a couple of years. With both species and several highly sought after crosses, Angraecums offer some very unique shapes along with the most pristine whites of any orchid. An amazing fact many people aren't aware of is that they can thrive both in South Florida's sub-tropical climate as well as on a windowsill in the not so warm north if given the chance. This presentation will provide both hobbyists as well as serious growers with fundamental guidelines to grow these beauties successfully and in turn, grace you with years of enjoyment. All of the photographs in the presentation

are of plants from Tom's collection; many of them showing all the various growth stages (from seedlings to first time bloomers to specimen plants).

We will have a mini-class from 7:45 – 8:00pm titled "Unusual and Natural Mounts". Tom will show how he mounts many of his orchids and how he tries to keep them as natural as possible. Some have become fantastic specimen plants in just a couple of short years.

The plant table will be provided by South Florida Orchid Society. We hope you can join us for this interesting and informative program.
