Below is their menu for our event. You have a choice of 2 salads and 10 different entrees. The price also includes



A truly spectacular tropical garden paradise - a private world of exotic and rare tropical plant specimens in a natural environment of tranquility and beauty - with an incredible home designed, with not so much with enclosed rooms, but rather open spaces that flow from interior to exterior with views of the gardens in all directions.

The house is built down in a rock pit that encloses the property and gives it a separation from the surrounding houses. The design incorporates the use of coral rock walls that meander from outside to inside, large expanses of glass sliding doors and windows, beautiful California Redwood and exceptionally high ceilings. It is a very comfortable interior environment in which to live, as well as being great for entertaining.

The garden is designed with elevated planting beds with paths in between. Oaks and ficus trees are throughout the landscape, which includes rock grottos and waterfalls. Planted are rare aroids, palms, heliconia, cycads, etc, each used as individual specimens rather than subjected to create plant masses. An eighteen foot high "barricade" along the north side of the property affords privacy, a spectacular hanging area for orchid display, as well as protection from north winter winds.
