The nursery sells orchids, some supplies and will assist any orchid grower with information and re-potting instruction.

The nursery is currently open by appointment Tuesday thru Sunday, 12 noon to 5 p.m.

Hurricane care tip: If you moved your plants into your house or garage, spray them with a solution of Physan-20, or SA-20 when you bring them out again. When you move your plants like this, it creates stress on them. All sorts of pathogens take advantage of this opportunity and attack weakened tissues to do their thing. Physan-20 and SA-20 are bactericides, fungicides, and algaecides, and they will go a long way in preventing any disease from taking advantage of the stressed plants.

Switching gears, now. The show was a complete success. Attendance was up from last year, and better than ever at the new location. Set-up, judging, hosting, selling, all different aspects of the show went fairly smoothly. Dan Christensen has proven himself the right person to chair this event.

My thanks to the members of the board who volunteered to help in one way or another during our show. My thanks to all the volunteers, society members, guests, vendors, exhibitors, and to the BankUnited facilities crew, for all their help during the show.




