President's Message



rain rain rain rain rain

FUNGI

June comes around and WAM! Rainy season is on. 15 inches of rain in a day might be good for ducks, but for our orchids? Not so much!

We could go into describing the different types of pathogens that prey onto our orchids. But, unless you have a photographic memory, the brief description I can provide here, will not help much. There are books in the matter. The AOS has a good one on their 'Orchid Pest and Diseases' product. Your own SFOS's book, 'An Introduction to Orchids, A Guide to Orchid Growing in the Subtropics', has a very informative chapter on pest and diseases. We have a SFOS member's discounted price of \$12.00 on this \$18.00 book.

The short of it is, if you see black, you have fungi. If they are smaller round spots, try first with a cinnamon paste, applied directly over the spot and on the underside of the leave. If it is a massive spot, you will need to cut off the sick leave and seal the wound with cinnamon.

A very popular choice is the combination of a topical fungicide (Dithane M-45) with a systemic one, (Thiomyl). You use two teaspoons of each in a gallon of water and spray your orchids once a week for three consecutive weeks. You can make a paste with either of these two fungicides and apply it the same way you did your cinnamon. There are other choices. And, I will be talking about them in our next meeting, June 21st.
