President's Message

Hello all:

We are almost there. The last month of 2017. I saw a posting on Facebook about fertilizing. I figured this will help our beginners remember what it all means.

Here is some basic information on fertilizers:



There. Now you know. Did you want to be a chemist, when you started in orchids? No, right?

Basic fertilizing 101:

N=Nitrogen=Growth/Leaves. P=Phosphorus=Blooms/Flowers. K=Potassium=Roots.

I will leave the discussion on phosphorus and non-phosphorus fertilizers and how they apply to orchid growing for another opportunity.

When it comes to orchids, my experience is that K.I.S.S. works best.

Now, you have to pay attention to the 'Guaranteed Analysis' on the back of your fertilizer label. It will tell you the source of your Macro Elements (NPK), and how many trace (micro) elements you have. To generalize, the more of those trace elements you have listed, the more complete is your fertilizer.
