The nursery sells orchids, some supplies and will assist any orchid grower with information and re-potting instruction.

The nursery is currently open by appointment Tuesday thru Sunday, 12 noon to 5 p.m.

Here is the rest of our schedule up to July 18th.



April 18th 2018 Judging Report




