SFOS April 16 2025 Program

Larry Cox "A Slipper Collection for South Florida."

Larry Cox acquired his first orchid, a cattleya, in 1972. His second was a paphiopedilum, Paph. Maudiae 'Magnificum.' The cattleya is long gone, but he still has a piece of the paph. When he began with paphs, he commonly heard, "You can't grow those in South Florida," but the first one lived and bloomed, and the paphiopedilum collection continued to grow. In the mid 1980's most of the other orchids were sold or given away, all for the love of paphs. In 1989, he moved from his South Miami residence to a more spacious property in the farming district of southern Miami-Dade County where he built his dream greenhouse of 3000 square feet. He has suffered setbacks, such as hurricane Andrew in 1992, but with perseverance and with the discovery of new paph species, and the consequent new hybrids, Larry's love of paphiopedilums has been renewed repeatedly. In 1983, Larry won his first AOS award for Paph. Maudiae coloratum 'Elektra' AM/AOS, one of the first vinicolors. Since then his orchids have earned over fifty AOS awards, including four ECC's.



A number of years ago, Larry retired from thirty-seven years as a teacher, the last fifteen teaching Advanced Placement high school English. He now spends his time reading, traveling, maintaining his property and, of course, growing paphs. Larry has experimented with other orchid genera and has found success with lycastes, phragmipediums, and pescatoreas. He has even rediscovered the wonder of cattleyas, particularly species.

Larry will be presenting a collection of twenty-five slipper orchids from three genera which he recommends for our climate and growing conditions!


































SFOS Proposed ByLaw Revisions

The South Florida Orchid Society ByLaw Review Committee (Chris, Charles, Margaret, Randy and Nancy) have successfully completed a review of the current ByLaws and would like to propose a thorough revision for 2025. Since this is a full revision of the original document, **please read it through carefully**. The Committee hopes you will find that it is much more in line with our current organization.

The Committee is proposing that the Society reduce the total number of Directors to be more in line with our current organizational size. The Committee also recommends that the Society set the terms of office to two years rather than three. The Committee feels that these changes will be advantageous and help SFOS recruit interested leaders for the long term. In addition, the Committee have fine-tuned the roles of all board positions, and reduced the number of Standing Committees.

The South Florida Orchid Society is grateful to all of the Board members who dedicated their time to this effort. And a Special Thank You to Nancy Crisler for taking on the considerable job of rewriting and preparing this document.

The South Florida Orchid Society Membership will be asked to approve the Committee's recommendations at the May Member's Meeting.


